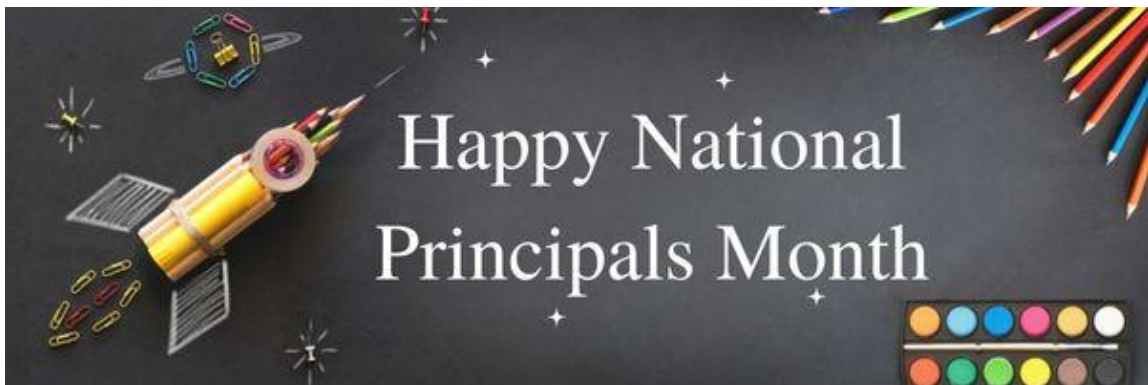

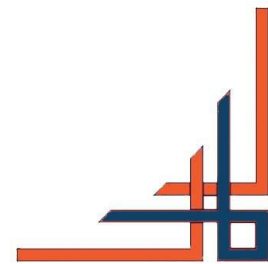

URBAN EDUCATION LEADERS PROGRAM

The Urban Education Leaders Program (UELPP) will begin its next cohort in Summer 2023. The application deadline is December 1, 2022.

The Urban Education Leaders Program (UELPP) at Teachers College, Columbia University is an executive education-style Ed.D. program that convenes for two weeks in the summer and one weekend per month during the regular academic year. In addition to coursework, case studies and field-based experiences, our structured approach to scaffolding the dissertation process provides the support and advisement working professionals need in order to complete their doctoral studies in a timely manner.

In UELPP, the opportunities to develop lasting professional relationships with classmates and faculty members are limitless. No work is more enduring than providing young people with high quality education, and never has the need for excellence in education leadership been more urgent.
